Our History: The Women in Action Group was known as East Hill Ladies and was started in an apartment on the Kent East Hill area in 1991. We moved to Covington Baptist Church and, in 1995, a woman named Mary Ann S. moved to the area, began looking for a women's meeting and helped shape the meeting into what it is today. As attendance grew, we moved to a portable at the church, then, when we outgrew that location, we moved to our current location at Maple Valley Presbyterian Church in 2001. After our move, a vote was taken and the name was changed to Women In Action.

Our group has a strong history as service oriented AA's. Many of us get together to sponsor a meeting at Lakeside Milam Recovery Center in Kirkland, carrying AA's message to the female residents at that facility. Several of us either presently serve or have served the district in some capacity.
